It was unanimously agreed to reject the quotation from Thomas Fox. 3. Clerk's Salary

It was proposed by Councillor Thompson, seconded by Councillor Tyler and unanimously agreed that the Clerk's salary be increased by £445.00 per annum to £7,855.00 per annum commencing 1^{st} April, 2020.

4. Cemetery/Burial Charges

It was unanimously agreed that there would not be any change in cemetery charges and that they would remain as follows:
