

**APPLICATION FORM TO INTRODUCE A MEMORIAL INTO
MICKLETON CEMETERY OR AMEND AN INSCRIPTION**

*Before completing this form, please ensure you have read and understood the **cemetery rules and regulations**. Completion of this form confirms that you will comply with the cemetery rules and regulations.*

*This form may be completed by the applicant or by any agent or craftsmen acting on behalf of the applicant, but it must be **signed by the grave owner**.*

Any person wishing to erect a headstone must be the grave owner and hold the exclusive right of burial. If the grave owner is deceased, the exclusive right of burial must be transferred via the legal process before the memorial application can be approved.
