Our statement of general policy, below, is based upon that required by virtue of the Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974. Although the council has a single employee, the principles of the Act and its underpinning Regulations as later published are taken by the council as a minimum requirement for the safe and effective management of the council and its activities.

Our statement of general policy is:

- To provide adequate control of the health and safety risks arising from our
- activities
- To consult with our staff on matters affecting their health and safety
- To provide and maintain safe equipment
- To provide sufficient information, instruction and supervision of staff, volunteers and visitors as far as is reasonably practicable
- To ensure all staff and volunteers are competent in their council-related
- activities, and to provide adequate training as far as is reasonably practicable
- To prevent accidents and activity-related ill health as far as is reasonably
- practicable
- To maintain safe and healthy conditions for conducting the council's business
- and the public facilities it provides
- To review and revise this policy as necessary at regular intervals, but at least
- annually.
